2 Opening Remarks. Pastor Brown.

3 PASTOR BROWN: Thank you.

4 Some of you I've met, some I haven't. I'm Arza  
5 Brown, I've been a chaplain with the police department now for  
6 25 years and I appreciate the opportunity that you give us at  
7 these meetings for us to come and to offer prayer.

8 (Commissioner Feinberg entered at 10:02 a.m.)

9 PASTOR BROWN: As we do today, I would like remember  
10 the Florence South Carolina Police Department. Their second  
11 officer of that department has died and he died yesterday, I  
12 believe. It's been three weeks and they -- I believe, if I  
13 remember right, they had eight, eight shot, I believe it was.  
14 And my son is Sergeant Richard Brown from the Wake Forest  
15 North Carolina Police Department, he is a -- with a national  
16 law enforcement chaplains group and he's been deployed to  
17 Florence to be there as a support for the officers and also  
18 for the funeral on Sunday. So I'd like just to remember  
19 those, those folks today if we could.

20 Father, we come to you here today, we're thankful  
21 for the privilege of serving, we're thankful for those who are  
22 willing to serve. We think of the passage in the scripture  
23 that says, If any man lack wisdom, let him ask of God, which  
24 giveth liberally, and upbraid him not. And I would pray for  
25 wisdom today as this committee meets, commission meets, the
