Page 4-3, line 36: add to the end of sentence "[...and adversely affect emergency response times and capacity.](#)"

Page 4-6, line 7: Add new Issue #5: "[The majority of Moloka'i's government, businesses and health care facilities, with the exception of the hospital and the new fire station, are located entirely within flood and tsunami inundation zones.](#)"

Page 4-6, line 7: Add new Issue #6: "[Puko`o Fire Station is the only emergency facility located on the East End of Moloka'i and is located within flood and tsunami inundation zones.](#)"

In 1968, Moloka'i Seed Service \(Corn Nuts, Moloka'i Ranch\) and Hawaiian Research \(Roland Holden\) began business on Moloka'i. In 1972, Moloka'i Seed Service sells to Hawaiian Research all of its assets including land leases on Moloka'i. December 2000 Monsanto purchases Hawaiian Research.](#)"
