

**Repeal of Liquor Commission Emergency Rules, of the LC May 13, 2020 meeting,
per Governor’s Executive Order 20-04 and First Amendment to the Liquor
Commission Emergency Rules, of the LC May 13, 2020 meeting, per Governor’s
Executive Order 20-04 adopted on April 13, 2021**

Governor David Y. Ige’s Emergency Proclamation related to COVID-19 and the disaster emergency relief period expired effective March 26, 2022, which brought an end to the Liquor Commission Emergency Rules, as amended, relating to the relaxing of certain requirements as it pertains to Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 281.

All emergency rules contained in the Liquor Commission Emergency Rules adopted on May 13, 2020 and First Amendment to the Liquor Commission Emergency Rules approved on April 14, 2021 are repealed effective March 26, 2022, except that the emergency rule regarding “Employee Approved by the Director” Card Expiration is repealed effective June 23, 2022.
